We are looking for quality vendors of handcrafted items and home-based businesses to display and sell their goods at the Sidney Gold Rush Days festival.

As of 2018, our festival will now span 3 days and vendors are more than welcome to setup Friday afternoon prior to 5:00 pm and remain open until 2:00 pm on Sunday. However, as usual, the core vendor business hours are on Saturday from 8:00 am until 6:00 pm. Vendors are required to be setup prior to 8:00 am and tear down after 6:00 pm in order to avoid interfering with festival activities.

As this is an outdoor event in Legion Park, vendors will want to provide their own awnings, tents, tables, and chairs. We have on-site security Friday and Saturday nights but due to the nature of the public venue we cannot be held responsible for your merchandise or fixtures during the event.

We have a limited number of 20 amp 110 volt and 50 amp 220volt power connections that are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Absolutely no generators.

Cost:

\$25.00 per trading post vendor. \$50.00 per ready to eat food vendor. \$10 electrical service fee.

** **Vendor fees are 100% refundable** if you remain open for the entire length of the core vendor business hours. The \$10 electrical service fee is not refundable. We are a non-profit organization and are very appreciative of those vendors who donate their vendor fee to help us keep this a free event.

Vendors are responsible for meeting Nebraska sales tax requirements.

We make every attempt to make this an 1870's period event so anything you can do to follow that theme will be appreciated. e.g. Dress in cowboy or pioneer garb, suspenders, jeans, plaid shirts, calico dresses, bonnets, etc...
