We are looking for quality vendors of handcrafted items and home-based businesses to display and sell their goods at the Sidney Gold Rush Days festival.

Our festival encompasses 3 days and vendors are more than welcome to setup Friday afternoon prior to 5:00 pm and remain open until 2:00 pm on Sunday. However, the core vendor business hours are on Saturday from 8:00 am until 6:00 pm. Vendors are required to be setup prior to 8:00 am and tear down after 6:00 pm in order to avoid interfering with festival activities.

New for 2020, we have reserved the Legion Park shelter house for all 3 days of the festival. There are approximately 12 indoor 10'x10' spaces available. These spaces have access to 110 volt electrical receptacles. These indoor spaces can be setup as early as 12:00 pm on Friday. The shelter house will be locked overnight.

Overall, this is an outdoor event in Legion Park, vendors will want to provide their own awnings, tents, tables, and chairs. We have on-site security Friday and Saturday nights but due to the nature of the public venue we cannot be held responsible for your merchandise or fixtures during the event.

For the outdoor spots, we have a limited number of 20 amp 110 volt and 50 amp 220volt power connections that are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Absolutely no generators.

\$25.00 deposit per trading post vendor.**

\$50.00 deposit per ready to eat food vendor.**

\$10 electrical service fee.

\$10 indoor fee

**** Vendor deposit fees are 100% refundable** if you remain open for the entire length of the core vendor business hours (8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturday). The \$10 electrical service fee and the indoor fee is not refundable. However, we are a non-profit organization and we are very appreciative of those vendors who donate their vendor fee to help us keep this a free event.

Vendors are responsible for meeting Nebraska sales tax requirements.

We make every attempt to make this an 1870's period event so anything you can do to follow that theme will be appreciated. e.g. Dress in cowboy or pioneer garb, suspenders, jeans, plaid shirts, calico dresses, bonnets, etc...

During the festival we have drawings for raffle prizes and a fund raising auction. Any and all donations are welcome and greatly appreciated.
