We are seeking high-quality vendors of handcrafted items and home-based businesses to showcase and sell their goods at the Sidney Gold Rush Days festival.

Our festival spans three days, and vendors are welcome to set up on Friday afternoon, before 5:00 pm, and remain open until 2:00 pm on Sunday. Historically, the core vendor business hours are Friday evening and Saturday from 8:00 am until 6:00 pm. We understand the issues with an outside festival regarding weather and setting up and packing up. We request that all vendors be onsite all 3 days for the full duration of the event.

In the event of a cancellation, it must be submitted to Kathy at vendors@sidneygoldrushdays.org by May 1st for a full refund. Any cancellations after that time will no longer be refunded. If you tear down or close early you will not be invited back the next year.

Outdoor spaces are 12x12. This is an outdoor event in Legion Park, vendors will want to provide their own awnings, tents, tables, and chairs. We have on-site security, Friday and Saturday nights but due to the nature of the public venue we cannot be held responsible for your merchandise or fixtures during the event.

For the food trucks/tents we have a limited number of 20-amp 120-volt and 50-amp 240-volt power connections that are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Absolutely no generators.

\$70.00 general merchandise vendor 12x12 space (\$120.00 for 2-12x12 spaces) Jan 1-Mar 31

\$90.00 general merchandise vendor 12x12 space (\$160.00 for 2-12x12 spaces) Apr 1-June 7

\$170.00 ready to eat food vendor Jan 1-Mar 31

\$200.00 ready to eat food vendor Apr 1-June 7

Payments must be received one week prior to the event to secure your spot.

Please note on your application if you want the same location as last year and if you wish to be next to someone. Once locations are set there will be no changing of your location.

Vendors are responsible for meeting Nebraska sales tax and food health department requirements.

We make every attempt to make this an 1870's period event so anything you can do to follow that theme will be appreciated. e.g., Dress in cowboy or pioneer garb, suspenders, jeans, plaid shirts, calico dresses, bonnets, etc...

During the festival we have drawings for raffle prizes. All donations are welcome and greatly appreciated.
